

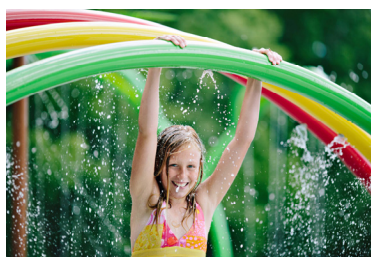
The Splash

Coming Soon...Miller J Fields Splashpad City of Lee's Summit, MO



The City of Lee's Summit, MO recently awarded their new Splashpad project to RJR Enterprises and Power Play. Construction has begun on the nearly 5,000 sq. ft. Splashpad with 28 ground sprays and 14 above ground features. The central spray feature of the Splashpad is the Super Splash. The Super Splash has a huge bucket that fills to the tipping point and then dumps water onto a rooftop, soaking everyone underneath. Other features include a misting Rainbow, two (2) raining Ombrellos, interactive Sunspray, dumping Flower, Bucket Trio, three (3) Water Cannons, 28 ground sprays, a Waterbug for the little ones and the always popular Aqua Dome. The City is planning for a grand opening around the beginning of July.

"Our community of Lee's Summit, MO (pop. 92,000) is very enthusiastic about our first Splashpad that will be installed in Miller J Fields Park this summer as part of a \$850,000 park renovation. Vortex and Power Play have been very helpful and responsive through the entire process including helping my planning and design staff better understand how Splashpad systems work, understanding the types of operating systems, and selecting equipment that meets our site conditions, specifications, and budget parameters. I believe our park patrons will be very pleased with the final product after it is installed this summer and we hope to be doing other Splashpads in the near future to complement our park system."

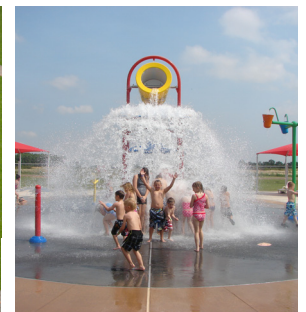
City of Duncan, OK To Open 2nd Splashpad This Summer

Construction of the Douglass Park Splashpad in Duncan, OK was completed last October and the City is looking forward to opening the new Splashpad. The Splashpad has taken the place of the Douglass Park Pool which had not been opened for the past 3 years due to the high cost



of maintaining and repairing the outdated pool. The 3,000 sq. ft. Splashpad has 16 ground sprays and 9 above ground features including a Sunspray, Bucket Trio, Aqua Dome, two (2) Water Cannons, and three (3) curved Silhouettes.

The City of The Village, OK is set to open it's unique heart shaped Splashpad this summer. The Splashpad features the Super Splash as it's central feature and includes a custom bucket with the Love's logo. Other features include a Bucket Trio, three (3) Spray Loops, Water Tunnel, Sunspray, three (3) Water Cannons, Aqua Dome and numerous other ground sprays.



"The Village started fundraising for the Splashpad about 9 years ago by putting on a Fall Festival for children in our area. Over the last 9 years, the City managed to raise \$45,000 from festival proceeds and from miscellaneous donations. However, we were a long way off until Love's Travels Stops helped us to make this become a reality with an \$80,000 donation.
